

# MUBS Hosts British Lebanese Business Group Meeting

The Modern University for Business and Science (MUBS) hosted the British Lebanese Business Group (BLBG) around a presentation *UK Education in Lebanon* for its first meeting of the New Year on 11 January 2018.
